The CETAPS/TEALS *Advanced Research Seminar* began in 2019 - its aim is to provide avenues of interaction between established and early career researchers and to address areas of research associated with languages in education. As a scientific seminar, it also aims to contribute towards breaking new ground in language education and to involve the presentation and discussion of both recently published work and research in progress.

The second *Advanced Research Seminar*, '**Challenges, solutions, and synergies**', takes a look at research-in-progress and has the following aims:

- (a) to encourage researchers, in particular early-career researchers, to share their work with a specific focus on any challenges they are encountering;
- (b) to offer a springboard for fruitful discussion within the context of work-in-progress;
- (c) to facilitate synergies for possible collaboration among established and early-career researchers;
- (d) to strengthen the sense of belonging within the CETAPS/TEALS research group.

All CETAPS/TEALS members are welcome to participate in the seminar, as presenters and or participants – it is free of charge.

Call for abstracts:

Abstracts will be accepted around unpublished research that looks at any of the following topics:

- language learning and education
- intercultural and or citizenship education
- language teacher education

Abstracts should be between 250 and 350 words and should outline the context, design, expected or real outcomes, and challenge(s).
